This webcast will outline how low income tenants and homeowners can access the Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP). WAP helps families reduce energy costs through the installation of energy efficiency measures. The webcast will also describe how dislocated workers and job seekers can access readiness training for weatherization and other green industry jobs. Under the American Recovery and Reinvest Act (ARRA), New York is receiving \$394 million for its Weatherization Assistance Program and \$169 million in Workforce Investment Act funding.

The program will be presented by the NYS Division of Housing and Community Renewal and NYS Department of Labor.

This program will be of interest to low income tenants and homeowners, owners of multi-family properties, dislocated workers, local governments, and community-based not-for-profit organizations.
